A lovely flat site for camping, close to the beautiful Severn Way - ideal for hikes and Duke of Edinburgh Award Expeditions. Walk to the source of the Severn!

The campsite is equipped for 24 campers but is large enough for 60 to 100 lightweight tents.

Altar fires are provided and there is a flagpole available.

The site facilities include a toilet block with basins, toilets and showers with hot and cold running water. There is also a toilet for disabled visitors. Adjacent to the toilet block is a small solid shelter and equipment store. There is a large upright fridge and similar freezer for campers' use.

Great for activities! There are four orienteering courses at Broneirion, geocaching and archery by arrangement. Other equipment is available for use by prior arrangement are: pioneering poles, 7 bikes and helmets, a Bouldering Hut, circus equipment, inflatable assault course and a variety of sports equipment and games.

Quad and pony trekking are also available nearby while a nature reserve is just three hundred metres away! There is a play park in Llandinam.



Staylittle Outdoor Centre provides sailing, canoeing, rock climbing and gorge walking and is just a short drive away from the site.

For days out, try the Vale of Rheidol miniature railway at Devil's Bridge or Powis Castle near Welshpool. There are local street and stock markets and the Centre for Alternative Technology ast Machynlleth is not far. The coast is just a 45 minute drive or catch the train from Caersws.
