





Cricket Power Kebabs!

Fuel up for your next cricket match with these delicious and colourful fruit kebabs! They're packed with vitamins and energy to help you hit sixes and bowl like a pro.


Ingredients:

Your favorite fruits! Here are some ideas:

- Strawberries (cut in half)
- Grapes (cut in half for younger girls)
- Pineapple chunks
- Honeydew melon chunks
- Kiwi slices (cut in half for younger girls)
- Blueberries
- Bamboo skewers
- Optional: Lemon juice (to keep apples from browning)

Instructions:

- Wash it up! Make sure all your fruits are clean and dry.
- Chop, chop! For younger girls, ask an adult to help you cut the fruits into bite-sized pieces. If you're using apple slices, you can drizzle them with a little lemon juice to keep them from turning brown.
- Get skewering! Carefully thread the fruit pieces onto the bamboo skewers. You can alternate colors to make a rainbow kebab, or create your own fruity design!
- Batter up! Now it's time to enjoy your delicious and healthy cricket power kebabs!







Double ton

Belinda Clark of Australia, not Sachin Tendulkar, was the first to smash a double ton in a one day International match. Belinda hit an unbeaten 229 runs off 145 balls against Denmark in Sachin's hometown of Mumbai during the 1997 Women's Cricket World Cup.

Captain

Heather Clare Knight OBE (born 26 December 1990) is an English cricketer who is captain of the **England women's** cricket team.



T20

England has been confirmed by the ICC as host of the 2026 Women's **T20 Cricket World Cup. This** will mark the first time the tournament has been held on these shores since 2009 when the hosts lifted the trophy by beating New Zealand in the final at Lord's.



Record breakers

Women's cricket broke spectacular new ground once again as a record attendance of 86,174 watched the T20 World Cup final between Australia and India at the Melbourne Cricket Ground.







Smoothie bowling

This Indian inspired smoothie is like sunshine in a cup, perfect for giving you fruity energy to dominate that cricket match!

Ingredients:

1 cup frozen mango chunks
1/2 cup frozen peach chunks
1/2 cup plain yogurt
1/3 cup coconut cream (from a can - ask an adult to help open it!)
1/2 cup milk (dairy or plant-based is fine!)
Honey or maple syrup (optional, to taste)

Instructions:

Prep party! Ask an adult to help you measure out the frozen fruit and yogurt.

Blend it up! Put all the ingredients in a blender. If your blender is feeling a little full, you can add the milk a bit at a time.

Get smooth! Blend everything together until it's nice and creamy. If your smoothie is too thick, add a splash more milk.

Taste test! Give your smoothie a try. If it's a little tart, you can add a drizzle of honey or maple syrup for extra sweetness.

Power up! Pour your Tropical Cricket Cooler into a cup and enjoy! Tips:

Don't have frozen fruit? No worries! You can use fresh fruit instead, but your smoothie might not be as cold.

Make it fancy! Pour your smoothie into a fun glass and decorate with a straw and a slice of mango or peach,

Feeling adventurous? Add a handful of spinach or kale to your blender for a hidden veggie boost!




